


# SPECIAL SPOTS AROUND THE CENTER FOR TRANSLATION STUDIES (CTS)


Looking for a place to unwind and relax between strenuous lessons?

## THE OLD TREE




A majestic old tree with a bench around its enormous trunk, perfectly designed to just sit down, look up to the lovely treetop, and breathe in the energy. ## THE SUNNY BENCHES





## THE PRIVATE SEATING CORNER





## THE DOG PARK




